**Description:** Type I, inherently buoyant, fabric-covered child life preserver for offshore use. This life jacket is designed with maximum buoyancy for high freeboard and quick righting of unconscious wearers. The large adjustable neck hole and flexible design provide superior comfort for the wearer, while the compact rectangular shape makes it easy to store. Also included are a PFD light attachment loop, SOLAS grade retro-reflective tape, and drain holes.

**Materials:** Lightweight PVC-based closed cell foam, sturdy nylon acrylic fabric, heavy 1" black polypropylene webbing, stainless steel D-rings and clip, aluminum slide, SOLAS grade retro-reflective tape.

2. Bring strap around back of the body to front and snap hook onto D-ring.
3. Tighten strap by pulling loose end and adjust for snug fit.
